- * Carcassonne - La Cite incredible medieval walled city built on a high crag
 - * Basilique St-Nazaire outstanding 14th- to 15th-century stained glass & 2 beautiful rose windows
 - * Chateau Comtal 12th century chateau
 - * Wonderful walled city with shops and restaurants
- * Rocamadour the Black Madonna of Rocamadour
 - * Chapelle Notre Dame (home to the Black Madonna and her ability to perform miracles)
 - * the Grand Escalier (200+ steps, once climbed by pilgrims on their knees)
 - * L'Hospitalet, with its views of the old town
- * Village of Saint-Cirq Lapopie perched on a cliff 100 m (330 ft) above the river and is one of the major beauty spots of the Lot valley. Many of the historic houses have stone or half-timbered fronts going back to the 13th-16th centuries.
- * Pech Merle Cave some of the finest prehistoric cave paintings in South West France
- * Teachings in the Mary Magdalene Mysteries, the Black Madonna, Cathars & History of the areas visited



Itinerary (order of days may change depending on hotel availability)

Day 1 Arrive at Marseilles airport & travel to nearby Saint-Maximin-la-Sainte-Baume near Aix en Provence, at the base of the Ste. Baume mountains (said to be final resting place of Mary Magdalene). Overnight in the area next 3 nights at the beautiful Hôtellerie Le Couvent Royal de Saint Maximin, originally a convent and later the residences of the Dominican fathers. Rooms overlook the cloister and the convent garden. This hotel/former convent is attached to the Basilica. Also lovely buffet breakfasts here. Dinners also served here in their lovely restaurant in the former Chapter House (extra).

Day 2 Breakfast. Morning teachings on the Black Madonna & Mary Magdalene. Here in Saint-Maximin-la-Sainte-Baume is the St. Madeleine Basilica (Mary Magdalene is said to have come here after the death of Jesus, and then died in St.



Baume). We will see the sarcophagus of St. Mary Magdalene as well as visit the Grotto of Marie Madeleine, after a 45 minute walk through the forest once held sacred by the Druids. Ste Mary Magdalene is supposed to have lived here in this grotto. Mary Magdelene is the patron saint of Provence.



Day 3- Breakfast. Continue above including some free time in the vibrant town of Aix en Provence.

Day 4 - Breakfast. Travel southwest,

this a.m, to Saintes-Mariesde-la-Mer on the Mediterra-



nean Coast (alleged landing site of Mary Magdalene after being cast adrift after the crucifixion - also venerated by Gypsies). Gypsies gather yearly in Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer for

a religious festival in honor of Saint Sarah also known as Sara-la-Kali (Sara the black). Some say this is a handmaiden to Mary Magdalene and some say a daughter. We will visit the St. Sarah



Crypt. Sara's statue is situated in the crypt of the church, at the right of the altar. She wears a multicoloured dress and jewels. Time to enjoy the seaside, beaches, and shopping.

Continue on this afternoon to Carcassonne area, in Languedoc-overnight next 4 nights at the beautiful Chateau de Cavanac.

Day 5 - Breakfast. Free morning at Chateau de Cavanac. Afternoon visit to the Black Madonna & healing well at Marceille. **Later afternoon visit to Lastours -** 13th century towers associated with the Cathars, built on the same rocky outcrop & Minerve - Lovely village associated with the Cathars & a massacre of them in 1210.



Day 6 - Teachings this morning on cathars & the area. Afternoon in the nearby, impressive, old walled city of Carcassonne with its wonderful turrets & vistas. Day & lunch on your own there with optional visits to **Chateau Comtal** - 12th century chateau, **Basilique St-Nazaire**, outstanding 14th- to 15th-century stained glass & 2 beautiful rose windows; shopping, exploring the walls and more.

Day 7- Teachings this morning & then travel to on Rennes-le-

Chateau - a place filled with mystery. The church is dedicated to Mary Magdalene and much mystery about buried treasure and more here.

Day 8- Travel to Albi & nearby Notre Dame de la Dreche and Black Madonna and Roman Spring; Mazamet - Cathar Museum; Montagne Noire - The Black Mountains - beautiful landscapes and incredible boulder-strewn landscape of Sidobre



Day 9 - Breakfast and check out of hotel & travel to Rocamadour -

Rocamadour has a beautiful and dramatic setting on a cliff & is an important pilgrimage destination. Built on the site of a shrine to a Madonna, the shrine became famous for its healing powers, and soon became a stop on the pilgrimage path to Santiago de Campostela.

Day 10 - Time to visit **Chapelle Notre Dame** (home to the Black Madonna and her abil-

ity to perform miracles), the Grand Escalier (200+ steps, once climbed by pilgrims on their knees), and L'Hospitalet, with its views of the old town. Also Visit the **Village of Saint-Cirq Lapopie** - perched on a cliff 100 m (330 ft) above the river and is one of the major beauty spots of the Lot valley. Many of the historic houses have stone or half-timbered fronts going back to the 13th-16th centuries.

Day 11 - Breakfast. Check out of hotel and travel to Pech Merle

Cave - some of the finest prehistoric cave paintings in South West France - The walls of seven of the chambers at Pech Merle have

fresh, life-like images of a woolly mammoth, spotted horses, solid colored horses, bovids, reindeer, handprints, and some humans. Footprints of children preserved in what was once clay are more than half a mile underground. The cave at Pech Merle is more than 1.5 miles long. The lower part of the network, where the prehistoric



galleries are situated, was



discovered in 1922 and opened to the public five years later. The paintings cover 300m (984ft) of wall, with about 700 animals, symbols and anthropomorphic figures depicted. Overnight near Toulouse airport for flights home in AM

Day 12-Trip ends. Transportation to Toulouse airport. Travel from Toulouse airport to Paris or other cities for flights home or longer on your own.
